Formats and Restrictions

- For each c <word> type of query in input file,
 - If the exact match of <word> is found in the original dictionary, output <word>+ and nothing else (no list is required to output).
 - Otherwise, output <word>: <suggestion1> <suggestion2> .. <suggestionN>, where suggestions are those words in dictionary that could be obtained from the typo rules, and those that appear in suggestion of form r <word> <suggestion>. The list of suggestions should be sorted first by the number of time it is suggested as correction in the user-input replacement list, then by lexicographical order.
- For each r <word> <suggestion> query, output nothing and simply add one to the corresponding replacement rule.
- Size restriction on dictionary (binary output from -b): Your output should be no larger than two times the original dictionary size.
- Size restriction on binary code: 256KB.
- Time limit on either constructing the dictionary or processing queries: 60 seconds. will not run forever.
- In general, you are allowed to use any libraries that can be compiled successfully within the size restriction above.
