

## Some Homework Guidelines

### 1 Hard Copy

Unless granted by the instructor in advance, you must turn in a written/printed copy of your solutions (without the source code) for all problems.

### 2 Submission By Parts

Each homework set contains 4–10 whole problems. For each whole problem, the students are allowed to submit it fully as a separate part (with names and problem numbers clearly marked) — no partial submission of the whole problem will be allowed. **Only the late parts would be penalized according to the course policy.**

Students can choose to re-submit each part to the TAs, but only the last submission will be used for grading purposes.

### 3 Source Uploading

Problems that are marked with (\*) need to come with the associated source code. The students should upload the source codes via the CEIBA system. First, pack your source codes for each problem separately. Create a single file (zip or tar.gz) for each problem. Then, go to

to upload the file associated with each individual problem.

### 4 Late Submission and Medal Use

The following are the SOP for late submission and medal use:

- (1) Submit the problems that you have readily finished (see Section 2)
- (2) Decide the number of medals to be used in this homework, and go to  
`http://tinyurl.com/ml12medal`  
to enter your decision **before the homework set is due.**
- (3) After finishing the late parts, write down your finishing time and submit the hard copy (see Section 1) to CSIE R536. If the door is closed, send a photo or a scan of your homework to `m12012ta at csie dot ntu dot edu dot tw` to prove your finishing time, and submit your write-up in the next few days.
